This three-day course will review and demonstrate the many uses of these devices. Many of these uses depend on Internet resources, so connecting to the Internet, and downloading Apps will be a focus, along with many basic device settings. The course will demonstrate how these devices can help you to: check your email, take and share pictures, transfer your pictures to your computer, read a book, watch a movie, listen to music, and play games. Apps determine what the device can do, so the class will concentrate on basic Apps such as *Google Playstore, Email, Calendar, Photos, Camera,* and *Settings*. Apps that expand the use of the device, such as *GoogleDrive, Photos,* and *Maps*, will also be discussed and demonstrated. A basic knowledge of your device is expected.
