

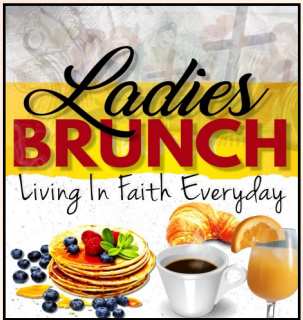


# Charge/Church Conference

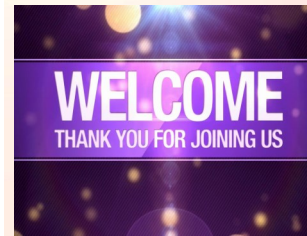
