This two-day course will review and demonstrate the many uses of these devices. Many of these uses depend on Internet resources, so connecting to the Internet, and downloading Apps will be a focus, along with many basic device settings. The course will demonstrate how these devices can help you to: check your email, take and share pictures, transfer your pictures to your computer, read a book, watch a movie, listen to music, and play games. Apps determine what the device can do, so the class will concentrate on basic Apps such as Google Playstore, Email, Calendar, Photos, Camera, and Settings. Apps that expand the use of the device, such as GoogleDrive, Photos, and Maps, will also be discussed and demonstrated. A basic knowledge of your device is expected.
